



First-Year Checklist:

- Incoming freshman are HIGHLY ENCOURAGED to apply to Summer Bridge**
- Attend CASP 101: July 26-28, 2017 (overnight stay during this program is optional, but recommended)
- Attend CASP Academic Year Kickoff: Thursday September 28, 2017 (Welcome Week)
- Meet with CASP Peer Leader (CPL) once per quarter and participate in quarterly activities, as available. Attend kickoff during Fall Quarter
- Meet with College academic advisor twice/quarter during your first year, and once per quarter in your second year. As needed in your consequent years at UCSD.
- Take EDS 50 (freshman) or EDS 150 (transfers) during Fall Quarter
- Register and attend Learning Communities (OLC's) during Winter & Spring Quarters
- Attend Faculty Speaker Series: Winter and Spring
- Reapply for FAFSA or CA Dream App. Priority deadline is March 2, 2018.
- Consider attending the CASP study jam the Friday before Finals Week every quarter (optional, but recommended)
